

Masters of Arts/Masters of Science Geography degree requirements

- ≥ 32 credit hours
- Course requirements
 - GEOG 471
 - GEOG 491
 - One GIS class
 - ≥ 12 hours at the 500 level, at least 8 of those hours in GGIS
- Thesis option (note, some programs areas require a thesis)
 - Prepare and defend a Masters thesis
 - Independent research in your area
 - Thesis committee – 3 faculty members, 2 from GGIS
- Exam option
 - 2 research papers (may be seminar/class papers)
 - Oral and written exams
 - Exam committee – 3 faculty members, 2 from GGIS
