Has a strong academic background in Social Sciences and Urban Studies. She is about field work, applied research, passionate activism bottom-up/collaborative action. Her professional experience ranges from archival research to project design and management. She has worked in different municipalities around the island of Puerto Rico supervising archaeological research, as field-worker and urban planner. In 2008, she took a turn in her professional career due to a growing interest in urbanism and moved to Barcelona where she completed a Master's degree in Collaborative Urban Design. Back in her homeland, she envisioned a great opportunity to combine all of her professional interest and co-funded Casa Taft 169, a grassroots initiative pursuing an "off-grid" rehabilitation of a long time abandoned property as headquarter for community based development and urban blight advocacy in Puerto Rico. Her experience placed her at the forefront of Todos Somos Herederos [We Are All Heirs] campaign to achieve new policies towards "public nuisances" without living owners or heirs. She worked for La Maraña, a nonprofit dedicated to participatory community planning. In 2017 she co-founded the Center for the Reconstruction of the Habitat ("CRH" by its Spanish acronym), the only organization in Puerto Rico that supports state and local governments, community organizations, and other nonprofits in their efforts to abate blight and create Community Land Banks. Her expertise includes urban mobility, pedestrian infrastructure, placemaking and sustainable urban development. Her professional interests range from experimental collaborative and multidisciplinary work to design and communication.
